
The Committee requests a review of the Federal Emergency Management Agency's Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant program. Specifically, the review should cover:

1. The risk-ranking methodology and how FEMA has quantified risk;
2. The amount of unexpended UASI funds and the process by which grant recipients spend money for allocated purposes;
3. FEMA's systemic application of past UASI-specific DHS OIG recommendations; and
4. FEMA's efforts to conduct oversight and prevent waste, fraud, and abuse in the UASI program.


